Class 1 Cross Pole Clear Round (may be assisted) £8 per round payable on the day (If entries are over-subscribed, this class may not run)

Class 2 40cm Team & Individual Championship (may be led/assisted) Judged on style only.

Class 3 50cm Team & Individual Championship (may be assisted)

Class 4 60cm Team & Individual Championship (may not be assisted)

Class 5 Introductory 70cm Team & Individual Championship (may not be assisted)**

Classes 3 – 5 will also have a style prize awarded to the rider with the best style round.

Important notice

**Horse/ riders combinations who have qualified to compete at the Grass Roots Regional Championships but have since jumped 80cm or above are eligible to compete in the 60cm & 70cm classes only.

Entry Fee Classes 2 – 5 £16 per horse/rider combination per class Paramedic first aid cover = £4 per rider per day
