Winter Eventers Challenge 2018-19

The course is made up of SJ & simulated XC fences with an optimum time & no style marks.

Riders will jump a series of show jumps and then proceed immediately into the XC phase which is run on an optimum time of 325- 375m/m. Jumping penalties have priority over time faults – so unlike Arena Eventing (JwS) ideally, you need to go clear to win!

Class 1 Mini 70-75cm Team & Individual (Hickstead qualifier)
Single phase. All team riders automatically count as individuals.

Class 2 Novice 80-85cm Team & Individual (Hickstead qualifier)
Single phase. All team riders automatically count as individuals.

Class 3 Intermediate 90-95cm Team & Individual (Hickstead qualifier)
Single phase. All team riders automatically count as individuals

Class 4 1m-1.05 Open Team & Individual (Hickstead qualifier)
Single phase. All team riders automatically count as individuals

Teams of 3 or 4, best 3 scores to count
Entry Fee for classes 1 -4 = **£20** per rider per round

Paramedic First Aid Cover £3 per rider for the day.

Jumping penalties are awarded as follows....

Knockdown (to include SJ and a few xc fences)	4 penalties
1st Refusal	4 penalties
2nd Refusal	8 penalties
3rd Refusal	Elimination
1st Rider Fall	Elimination
Horse Fall	Compulsory Retirement
Starting before the bell /Retaking an obstacle already jumped/ Error of course	Elimination
Every commenced second over or under the optimum time	1 penalty
Exceeding time limit (3 times the time allowed)	Elimination
Speed 325-375 metres / minute. No stopwatches allowed.	

Body protectors are compulsory. Hair must be above collar length, long hair to be kept in place in a hair net. Crash hats, no fixed peak SJ hats.

In the event of a tie, the competitor closest to the optimum time will be the winner. If teams are tied, the times of the 3 best scores closest to the optimum time will be the winner.

- All persons Must wear a riding hat/helmet to current UK Safety Standards with a 3 point harness whilst mounted at all times
- The judge's decision is final. Any objections must be made to the Organiser/Secretary by the Team Manager only, within 15 minutes of the incident with a deposit of £30, which will be refunded if the objection is upheld.
- Please close the gate on entering and exiting KSEC at all times
- Please take all your rubbish home
- Please pick up your horse droppings and hay from the car park
- Mucking out of trailers and lorries on site is forbidden
- Dogs on leads at all times
- No smoking or dogs allowed in arena
- We reserve the right to run classes early (or late),
- We hold a strictly controlled warm up at KSEC no more than 2 teams warming up at one time whilst another team jump.
- Only the team manager or 1 nominated team person may enter the warm up to assist children within the warm up area.
- No spectating from warm up area. Please stand outside.
- All schools must be members of the NSEA – see website for NSEA Insurance details. Hot and cold food and drinks will be available all day. If you wish to book overnight or day stabling please call KSEC on 01458 211111
