- Class 3** Intermediate 90-95cm Team & Individual Qualifier.
All team riders automatically count as individuals
- Class 4** Open 1.00-1.05m Team & Individual Qualifier
All team riders automatically count as individuals
- Class 5a** Advanced 1.10 Individual Qualifier (Horse)
Class 5b Advanced 1.10 Individual Qualifier (Pony)
* 1st to 2nd placed individuals from each section to qualify for National Championships
* 3rd to 8th placed individuals from each section to qualify for Championship Plate
