Class 1 60cm Warm Up non national qualifier, (including Grass Roots Qualifier for eligible riders)

Class 2 Mini 70-75cm Team & Individual Qualifier

(Riders to be aged under 14 on 1st January 2024)

Single phase. All team riders automatically count as individuals.

Class 3 Novice 80-85cm Team & Individual Qualifier

Single phase. All team riders automatically count as individuals.

Class 4 Intermediate 90-95cm Team & Individual Qualifier.

Single phase. All team riders automatically count as individuals

Class 5 1m-1.05 Open Team & Individual Qualifier

Single phase. All team riders automatically count as individuals

Class 6 a/b 1.10m Advanced Open Individual Qualifier

(2 x horses and 2 x ponies to qualify)

Single phase. This class will be split into 5a) Horses, 5b) Ponies
