Class 0 Cross Pole Clear Round (may be led/assisted) £10

Class 1 40cm Team & Individual Grass Roots Qualifier (may be led/assisted) £18

Judged on style. Not timed

Class 2 50cm Team & Individual Grass Roots Qualifier (may be assisted) £18
Single phase - All team riders automatically count as individuals (Teams of 3 or 4, best 3 scores to count)

Class 3 60cm Team & Individual Grass Roots Qualifier (may not be assisted) £20
Single phase - All team riders automatically count as individuals (Teams of 3 or 4, best 3 scores to count)

Class 4 70cm Team & Individual Grass Roots Qualifier (may not be assisted) £20
Single phase - All team riders automatically count as individuals (Teams of 3 or 4, best 3 scores to count)

Class 5 70cm Mini County Qual (Warks) incl RPL Teams & Individuals (Open to all) £25
Single phase - All team riders automatically count as individuals (Teams of 3 or 4, best 3 scores to count)

Class 6 80cm Novice County Qual (Warks) incl RPL Teams & Individuals (Open to all) £25

Single phase - All team riders automatically count as individuals (Teams of 3 or 4, best 3 scores to count)

Class 7 90cm Intermediate County Qual (Warks) incl RPL Teams & Individuals (Open to all) £25 Single phase - All team riders automatically count as individuals (Teams of 3 or 4, best 3 scores to count)

Class 8 1m Open Intermediate County Qual (Warks) £25

Single phase - All team riders automatically count as individuals (Teams of 3 or 4, best 3 scores to count)

Classes 1 – 4 NSEA Grass Roots Rules apply Classes 5 - 8 NSEA 30cm Rule applies

Grass Roots Rules for classes 1 - 5 See also NSEA Rules 2022

GR1) Classes & Eligibility

Grass Roots 40 & 50cm classes (for very novice riders only)

40cm Grass Roots (Riders may be led or assisted)
Classes are judged on rider position and style only over a simple course of fences.

There is a very generous **maximum time** only. Classes may be split into a) led and b) assisted.

There will be an additional prize for the most stylish rider who jumps clear in this class

ANY RIDER who has competed in ANY 70cm class (or higher) on ANY pony at ANY competition (not just NSEA) is NOT eligible for this class, (except h/c if space permits)

50cm Grass Roots. (Riders may be assisted but not led.)

Optimum time. The winner will be the horse/rider combination who have the fewest jumping penalties and are closest to the optimum time.

There will be an additional prize for the most stylish rider who jumps clear in this class

ANY RIDER who has competed in ANY 80cm class (or higher) on ANY pony in ANY competition (not just NSEA) is immediately ineligible for Grass Roots 40 & 50 cm qualifiers & Championship classes.

ANY HORSE/RIDER combination who has qualified for any other NSEA CHAMPIONSHIPS (SJ / JwS CHQ, ECQ, County etc) may not compete in Grass Roots 50cm classes.

Grass Roots 60 & 70cm classes (for novice riders)

60cm Grass Roots

Single phase competitions, no outside assistance.

Horse/ Rider combinations who have **completed 4** courses at 80cm (at ANY competition, not just NSEA competitions) may only compete h/c in 60cm classes, unless they ride a different pony.

70cm Grass Roots

Single phase, no outside assistance Riders jumping at this level are not eligible for 40cm Grass Roots on ANY pony. Rider / pony combinations jumping at this level are NOT eligible for 50cm classes.

The purpose of the Grass Roots programme is to provide very novice riders with the opportunity to experience the excitement of competition. The rules are, therefore, kept as flexible as possible but, please embrace the "spirit" of the rules. Please do not use Grass Roots competitions as an easy opportunity to "pot hunt," as it is not in the spirit of the competition.

The top 6 teams & individuals at qualifiers will be eligible to compete at any Regional Grass Roots Championships.

Entries

- All entries will only be accepted online in advance of the show via the NSEA Entry System
- The show organisers have the right to cancel any, part of, or an entire show.
- Show organisers reserve the right to refuse entries without assigning a reason.
- Each competitor must have appropriate insurance, owner or where applicable, parent or guardian, shall be solely responsible for consequences of loss or damage done to, occasioned by, or arising from any animal in their care.

Withdrawals

- Withdrawals / changes prior to close of entries please contact NSEA
- Withdrawals / changes after close of entries to beth@allenshill.co.uk
- No refunds will be made after close of entries.
- All horses / ponies / travel companions must be up to date vaccinations against Equine
 Influenza as per current NSEA rules.
- Please ensure you bring your equine passport.
- On arrival at the show, all entries will be checked at the gate.
- Horses / Ponies are not permitted to be tied up outside your vehicle.
 - No tying up of haynets outside lorries/trailers
- Correct and safe dress must be worn at all times.
- Protective headgear must be worn at all times when mounted on any part of the showground.
- It is the duty of riders and in the interest of safety, to ensure that their headgear provides proper protection, is correctly fitted and remains in place.
- Horses must not be left unattended or tied to the outside of lorries/trailers.
- There is a £20 penalty for any horses found digging a hole in the car park.
- Toilets are located on the carpark.
- Dogs are only permitted in the carpark and must be kept on a short lead.
- Please bring your own water for your horse.
- Competitions will be run in accordance with the NSEA Rule Book.
- The number of competitors in the warm up will be restricted. A separate flatwork warm up will be available.
- No unauthorised persons shall enter the competition or collecting rings.
- Please ensure that your parking area is clear of all poo / hay and litter before leaving.
- There is a £20 penalty for any untidy parking area.

Your Responsibility

All persons attending the event must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents and must obey instructions given by the Organiser or by officials and stewards on its behalf.

All competitors and those associated with their school are the responsibility of the Team Manager whilst at the competition
