*At the Inter-county finals, each county will be represented by the following horse/rider combinations who
have qualified in this competition:*

1 x prelim restricted (P1) rider (not to have competed at novice level)

1 x Prelim Open rider (P1)

1 x Novice rider (N2)

1 x restricted team (4 x P1)

1 Open Team (2 x P2 & 2 x N2)

All team riders automatically count as individuals. Placings are not passed down.

This competition is open to schools from all counties and will also count for RPL
points

Entries Close : Friday 7th February 2025.

Late entries accepted from Saturday 8th February with a £3 late
entry fee per class.

The Course is made up of SJ & simulated XC fences with an optimum time & no style marks. Larger
arenas may use secured XC portables. Riders will jump a series of show jumps and then proceed
immediately into the XC phase which is run on an optimum time of 350- 375m/m.

Class W – 60 warm up class. (non qualifier)

Class 1 Mini 70-75cm Team & Individual (Hickstead qualifier)
Single phase. All team riders automatically count as individuals.

Class 2 Novice 80-85cm Team & Individual (Hickstead qualifier)
Single phase. All team riders automatically count as individuals.

Class 3 Intermediate 90-95cm Team & Individual (Hickstead qualifier)
Single phase. All team riders automatically count as individuals

Class 4 1m-1.05 Open Team & Individual (Hickstead qualifier)
Single phase. All team riders automatically count as individuals

Teams of 3 or 4, best 3 scores to count

Dressage Classes:

Tests at Championship Qualifiers 2024 (Team & Individual) all in 20x40m arenas as follows.

Class 5 Warm Up class

Prelim 3 (2024)/N1 (2024). Highest % wins overall. (will be split if more than 12 in the class into Prelim and Novice tests).

Team Qualifiers

Teams (of 3 or 4 , the best 3 percentage scores to count)

A horse/rider combination may only compete in one team.

Class 6 County Prelim Teams

open to 3/4 x prelim riders that have never ridden above BD bronze prelim level, any novice level dressage (affiliated or unaffiliated,) open pony club or novice BE eventing.

Test: Prelim 1 (2024)

The winning team from each respective county will represent their county at the NSEA Inter County Finals.

(2023 Inter-County Prelim Team Champions- King's Macclesfield, Cheshire)

Class 7 County Open Teams

(2 x prelim riders & 2 x novice riders)

Prelim section is open to horse & rider combinations that have not competed at British Dressage Elementary level or above. Novice section is open to all.

Teams of 3 / 4 riders, best 3 % scores to count

Test: Prelim 2 (2024)

Test: Novice 2 (2024)

The winner from each respective county will represent their county at the NSEA Inter County Finals.

(2023 Inter-County Open Team Champions –Cranleigh, Surrey)

Individual Qualifiers (to be run in conjunction with the team tests)

Class 8 County Individual Prelim Qualifiers

Class 8A County Prelim Restricted Individual Prelim1 (2024)– Rider to have only competed at prelim level

Class 8B County Prelim Open Individual Prelim2 (2024)– open to all horse/ rider combinations who have not competed at Elementary level or above, or BE Intermediate level.

Class 9 County Individual Novice Qualifiers

Novice 2 (2024)

Open to rider/horse combinations not to have competed at BD Medium level or above or BE Intermediate level.

The winning individual from each respective county individual class will represent their county at the NSEA Inter County Finals. (one per county only)

If there are two sections per class, a ride off will determine the result.

Entry Fee for classes W & 1 -4 = **£26** per rider per round.

Classes 5-9 (dressage classes) = **£20** per rider per class. Late entries £3 extra if space permits. Fee includes First Aid cover.

NSEA Eventers Challenge Rules for Scoring 2024-25

The intention of these rules is to reward riders who have a clear round and to penalise riders who have jumping penalties or who are significantly faster than the Optimum Time. Where there are several competitors with a clear round, then the nearest to the Optimum Time will win, rewarding an appropriate judgement of pace around the course.

EC1) Open to Teams and Individuals

- Riders will jump a course of 5-8 show jumps and then proceed immediately into the XC phase of 8-15 simulated XC fences, depending on the size of the arena
- The speed for the XC phase will be between 320m/m to 375m/m depending on the size of the arena – smaller arena = tighter turns which slow you down. A larger arena with flowing lines will ride on a quicker time. The speed for each class will be given in the schedule or on the noticeboard at the event. Times will be recorded to one-hundredth of a second if the timing equipment allows.
- NSEA/BE Eventing Rules for tack and rider equipment for XC.
- There will be no style mark. No age restriction on the mini (70/75) class.
- Top two teams and 4 Individuals at each height to qualify for the NSEA Eventers Challenge Championship to be held at Hickstead in May.

EC2) Dress: XC colours, body protectors are compulsory. Hair must be above collar length, long hair to be kept in place in a hair net. Rider must wear BE approved skull caps, no fixed peak SJ hats.

EC3) The competitor with the fewest penalties wins. In the event of a tie, the competitor closest to the optimum time will be the winner. In the team competition, the total of the best three scores is used to place the team. The combined difference from the Optimum Time of the 3 best scores is used to break any ties.

EC4) The top 2 teams & 4 individuals at each qualifier will qualify for the NSEA Eventers Challenge Championship.

EC5) Organisers are asked to ensure that the XC phase includes elements that give a choice about the track and therefore the time taken. Organisers are asked not to display a clock showing the time taken visible to the rider to as the aim is to educate riders to ride by feel.

Penalties are awarded as follows

Knockdown (to include SJ and knockable xc fences)	4 penalties
1st Refusal	4 penalties
2nd Refusal	8 penalties
3rd Refusal	Elimination
Rider Fall	Elimination

Horse Fall	Elimination
Starting before the bell, retaking an obstacle already jumped, error of course or outside assistance	Elimination
Where the Optimum Time is 120 seconds or less, for every commenced second in excess of 10 seconds under the optimum time	1 penalty
Where the Optimum Time more than 120 seconds, for every commenced second in excess of 15 seconds under the optimum time	1 penalty
Exceeding time limit (2 times the Optimum Time)	Elimination
