County Challenge Dressage Qualifiers for Berkshire; Greater London; Surrey and West Sussex & RPL Dressage open to all. (Teams & Individuals)

The highest placed team & individual for the relevant county in each class will be given the title 'County Champion'

The RPL competition is open to schools from all Counties and will count only for RPL points

Class 1a County Prelim Restricted Teams (Best 3 scores to count)

Open to 3/4 x prelim <u>riders</u> who have never ridden above BD bronze prelim level, any novice level dressage (affiliated or unaffiliated,) open pony club or novice BE eventing.

Test: Prelim 14 2006 (revised collective marks 2016)

The winning team from each respective county will represent their county at the NSEA Inter County Finals.

Class 1b County Individual Restricted Prelim Qualifiers Test: Prelim 14 2006 (revised collective marks 2016) Rider to have only competed at prelim level (as above).

Class 2 County Open Teams Individual (Best 3 scores to count)

(2 x prelim riders & 2 x novice riders) Prelim section is open to horse & rider combinations that have not competed at British Dressage Elementary level or above. Novice section is open to all.

Test: Prelim 14 2006 (revised collective marks 2016) x 2 riders Test: Novice 27 (2007) x 2 riders

The winning team from each respective county will represent their county at the NSEA Inter County Finals.

Class 2a County Individual Novice Qualifiers

Test: Novice 27 (2007)

Open to rider/horse combinations not to have competed at BD Medium level or above or BE Intermediate level.

The organisers or Proprietors will not accept any liability for any accident, damage or illness to horses, owners, riders, spectators or other persons or their property whatsoever and howsoever caused. It shall be a condition of entry that each entrant shall indemnify the organisers and their respective officials, servants, representatives and agents against any legal action or claim arising in connection with the event.
