DRESSAGE

Tests at National Championship Qualifiers 2023 (Team & Individual) all in 20x40m arenas as follows..

Class 1 Prelim = P 13 (2006) Team & Individual Qualifier
Class 2 Novice = N 28 (2008) Team & Individual Qualifier
Class 3 Elementary = E 50 (2007) Individual Qualifier Only

Entry Fee £20 per test including First Aid cover

Teams

Teams shall be made up of 3 or 4 riders, best 3 scores to count. Up to two riders to compete in the prelim test and up to two riders in the novice test.

All team riders will automatically count for individual placings providing they are eligible (see NSEA 'Additional rules')

The top 2 teams & 2 Individuals per section will qualify for the Championships

Please note that Dressage tests at the Championships will be:

Championship Individual Tests 2022 all ridden in **20x60m** arenas
Prelim 17A (2017), Novice 37A (2017) (Elementary 55 (2019),

Championship Team Tests 2022 all ridden in **20x40m** arenas
Team Tests = Prelim 14 (2006) revised collectives 2016 (up to two riders), Novice 34 (2009) (up to two riders

County Challenge Dressage Qualifiers for Devon and Cornwall and & RPL Dressage open to all (teams & individuals)

The highest placed team & individual for the relevant county will be given the title
'County Champion'

Team & Individual County Qualifiers for the County Championships at Hickstead, May 2023

Entries to: NSEA

Entries Close: 19th March

Team Qualifiers

Teams (of 3 or 4 , the best 3 percentage scores to count)

A horse/rider combination may only compete in one team.

Class 1 County Prelim Teams

Open to 3/4 x prelim riders that have never ridden above BD bronze prelim level, any novice level dressage (affiliated or unaffiliated,) open pony club or novice BE eventing.

Test: Prelim 14 2006 (revised collective marks 2016)

The winning team from each respective county will represent their county at the NSEA Inter County Finals.

Class 2 County Open Teams

(2 x prelim riders & 2 x novice riders)

Prelim section is open to horse & rider combinations that have not competed at British Dressage Elementary level or above. Novice section is open to all.

Individual Qualifiers

Test: Prelim 14 2006 (revised collective marks 2016) x 2 riders

Test: Novice 27 (2007) x 2 riders

The winner from each respective county will represent their county at the NSEA Inter County Finals.

Class 3 County Individual Prelim Qualifiers

Prelim 13

3A County Prelim Restricted Individual – Rider to have only competed at prelim level

3B County Prelim Open level – open to all horse/ rider combinations who have not competed at Elementary level or above, or BE Intermediate level.

Class 4 County Individual Novice Qualifiers

Novice 24

Open to rider/horse combinations not to have competed at BD Medium level or above or BE Intermediate level.

The winning individual from each respective county individual class will represent their county at the NSEA Inter County Finals. (one per county only)

If there are two sections per class, a ride off will determine the result.
