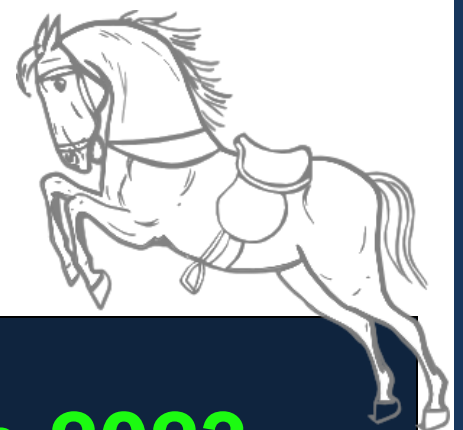
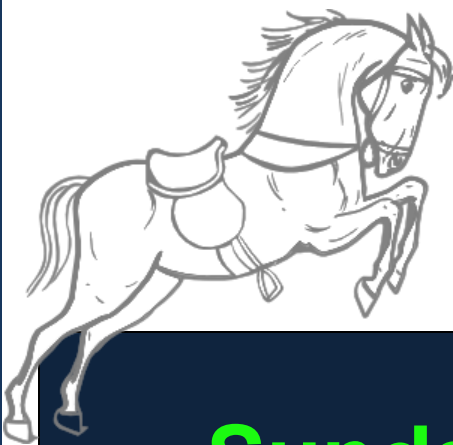

# ALL CLASSES ARE PRE-ENTRY ONLY

## **Class 1 – 40cm. Teams & Individuals**

Riders may be led or assisted. Course of 8 jumps judged on rider position and style (not timed)

## **Class 2 – 50cm. Teams & Individuals**

Optimum Time. Riders may be assisted but not led. Judged on fewest jumping penalties and closest to optimum time

## **Class 3 – 60cm. Teams & Individuals**

Single phase. No outside assistance is permitted.

## **Class 4 – 70cm. Teams & Individuals**

Single phase. No outside assistance is permitted.

## **Class 5 – 80cm. Teams & Individuals. Regional Points League**

Single phase. No outside assistance is permitted

## **Class 6 – 90cm. Teams & Individuals. Regional Points League**

Single phase. No outside assistance is permitted

## **Class 7 – 1.00m. Team & Individuals. Regional Points League**

Single phase. No outside assistance is permitted

**Entry fee £21.00 per Individual per class including medical cover  
Teams of 3 or 4 with best 3 scores to be used**

## **RULES - NSEA 2022-23, BS AND THE FOLLOWING TO APPLY.**

**Your Responsibility** - All persons attending the event must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents and must obey instructions given by the Organiser or by officials and stewards on its behalf. All competitors and those associated with their school are the responsibility of the Team Manager whilst at the competition All enquiries are to be made by the Team Manager.

**TV & Photography** - Please note that professional photographers will be present at NSEA competitions. There may also be TV cameras at the Championships. Please indicate on the entry form if you do not wish to appear in press coverage/ TV or photos taken by our official photographers

**General information** - Please ensure that horses are not tied up outside vehicles and left unattended at any time. All droppings must be picked up and the car left clean and tidy. All dogs must be kept on leads at all times. Any dog mess must be cleared up.

Outside assistance will not be tolerated unless stated within the schedule - and could result in elimination. NSEA affiliated competitors only may warm up & compete horses on the show ground. All competitions, parents and representatives from every school must ensure that they act courteously to stewards and officials at all times. Most of them are volunteers and rudeness is not acceptable. In the event of cancellation, your entry will be refunded less £5 per class admin fee.

### **DISCLAIMER**

The organisers reserve the right to eliminate any competitor whose riding helmet is not fastened when mounted. Riding helmets must bear the current safety standards for British Show jumping. The organisers strongly recommend that competitors wear body protectors, hairnets are compulsory for hair longer than shoulder length. The organiser of this event has taken reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring and must obey the instructions of the organisers, officials and stewards. Any damages must be paid for. Vehicles, boxes and trailers and are parked entirely at the owner's risk. Anyone entering this competition will be deemed to have agreed to abide by the rules in this schedule and current NSEA rules. All schools to provide their own arena party when their pupils are competing. The organisers reserve the right to cancel the event, in which case entry fees will be refunded (less £5 per competitor). In the event of adverse weather conditions the competition will be rescheduled. Riders' start times will emailed to team managers. Competitors will only be able to walk the course at the beginning of each class or during specified times.
