Team Qualifiers

Teams (of 3 or 4 , the best 3 percentage scores to count)

A horse/rider combination may only compete in one team.

Class 1 County Prelim Teams

open to 3/4 x prelim riders that have never ridden above BD bronze prelim level, any novice level dressage (affiliated or unaffiliated,) open pony club or novice BE eventing.

Test: Prelim 12 (2005) revised 2016

The winning team from each respective county will represent their county at the NSEA Inter County Finals.

(2023 Inter-County Prelim Team Champions- Abbotsholme, Cheshire)

Class 2 County Open Teams

(2 x prelim riders & 2 x novice riders)

Prelim section is open to horse & rider combinations that have not competed at British Dressage Elementary level or above. Novice section is open to all.

Teams of 3 / 4 riders, best 3 % scores to count

Test: Prelim 14 (2006) revised 2016 x 2 riders

Test: Novice 27 (2007) x 2 riders

The winner from each respective county will represent their county

at the NSEA Inter County Finals.

(2023 Inter-County Open Team Champions – Mayfield, East Sussex)

Individual Qualifiers (to be run in conjunction with the team tests)

County Individual Prelim Qualifiers

Class 1A County Prelim Restricted Individual Prelim 12(2005) revised 2016 – Rider to have only competed at prelim level

Class 2B County Prelim Open Individual Prelim 14 (2006) revised 2016 – open to all horse/ rider combinations who have not competed at Elementary level or above, or BE Intermediate level.

Class 2C County Individual Novice Qualifiers

Novice 27 (2007)

Open to rider/horse combinations not to have competed at BD Medium level or above or BE Intermediate level.

Entry Fees for all other classes = £18

The winning individual from each respective county individual class will represent their county

at the NSEA Inter County Finals. (one per county only)

If there are two sections per class, a ride off will determine the result.

- It is mandatory for all riders to wear a protective helmet to British standard EN1384 or PAS015 at ALL times while mounted.
- Horses and Ponies MUST NOT be tied to the side of horseboxes or trailers and left unattended – please clear up any mess left by you or your horses
- Vaccinations: Horses and Ponies must be accompanied by their passport and must have Equine Flu vaccinations in date within 12mths. Spot checks may take place.
- Smoking: - No smoking or drinking of alcohol in the arena or viewing area
- All competitors/owners and their guests are required to adhere to commonly accepted standards of decency and good behaviour. Racial abuse, discrimination, swearing and loud or aggressive conduct will not be tolerated.
- No mucking out onto any indoor or outdoor areas. An immediate fine of £20 will apply if this is seen to take place.
- Litter is to be taken home with you or disposed of in the big bins provided. Please use recycling bins if provided.

Children under 16 must be supervised at all times.

Please return any equipment used back to its storage area after use

DOGS - Dogs must be kept on leads & under appropriate control at all times. Dogs must be cleared up after.

Vehicles - The Show Organiser reserves the right to remove any vehicle which is obstructing any access to or from the ground even if locked and unattended. The Show Organiser will not be liable for any injury, loss or damage occasioned by such removal.

Your Responsibility

All persons attending the event must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents and must obey instructions given by the Organiser or by officials and stewards on its behalf.
