<u>**Class 1</u>** - 40cm Team & Individual Grass Roots Qualifier (may be led/assisted) Judged on jumping penalties, placings separated on style marks. Not timed a) led, unled and running in close proximity with the pony. b) assisted- in the ring but instructor does not move with the pony *Top 6 individuals in each section to qualify. Top 6 teams to qualify, which can be made up of riders in either section*</u>

<u>Class 2</u> - 50cm Team & Individual Grass Roots Qualifier (may be assisted) Optimum time

<u>Class 3</u> – 60cm Team & Individual Grass Roots Qualifier (may not be assisted) Single phase

<u>Class 4</u> - 70cm Team & Individual Grass Roots Qualifier (may not be assisted) Single phase

Class 5 - 70cm RPL Teams & Individuals Single phase

Class 6 - 80cm RPL Teams & Individuals Single phase

Class 7 - 90cm RPL Teams & Individuals Single phase

Class 8 - 1m RPL Teams & Individuals Single phase

#### Classes 1 – 4 NSEA Grass Roots Rules apply

Horse/rider combinations may compete in two consecutive height classes on the same pony 40 & 50 or 50 & 60 or 60 & 70cm - A GR rider may not jump in 70cm and 40cm or 50cm classes (except h/c) - A rider is not eligible for GR if they are jumping 90cm and if they have completed 5 x 80cm classes anywhere they may only jump 60 and 70 GR classes. - NSEA Rules – For the comprehensive Grass Roots Rules go to NSEA General Rules on the NSEA website.

The purpose of the Grass Roots program is to provide very novice riders with the opportunity to experience the excitement of competition. The rules are, therefore, kept as flexible as possible but, please embrace the "spirit" of the rules. Please do not use Grass Roots competitions as an easy opportunity to "pot hunt," as it is not in the spirit of the competition.

#### The top 6 teams & individuals at qualifiers will be eligible to compete at any Regional Grass Roots Championships.

#### Classes 5 – 8

30cm rule applies, competition is open to schools from all counties and will count for RPL points. For full rules please refer to the NSEA Rule General rules on the NSEA website.

#### Your Responsibility

All persons attending the event must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents and must obey instructions given by the Organiser or by officials and stewards on its behalf.

All competitors and those associated with their school are the responsibility of the Team Manager whilst at the competition. All enquiries are to be made by the Team Manager please.

Please note that professional photographers will be present at NSEA competitions. There may also be TV cameras at the Championships. Please indicate on the entry form if you do not wish to appear in press coverage/ TV or photos taken by our official photographers

Outside assistance will not be tolerated- and could result in elimination. NSEA affiliated competitors only may warm up & compete horses on the show ground. Spur and whip rules must be adhered to.

All competitions, parents and representatives from every school must ensure that they act courteously to stewards and officials at all times. Most of them are volunteers and rudeness is not acceptable.

In the event of cancellation, you entry will be refunded on receipt of a sae, less £5 per cheque admin fee.
