1st & 2nd placed team & 1-4th placed individuals will qualify for the 27th annual **NSEA National Schools Championships October 2025**

3rd -8th placed team & 5th-8th placed individuals will qualify for the NSEA Championship Plate October 2025

<u>Class 1</u> Warm Up 60cm (non county Qualifier) also Grass Roots Qualifier (Individual)

<u>Class 2</u> Mini 70-75cm Team & Individual Qualifier
Riders to be aged under 14 on 1st January 2024, All team riders automatically count as individuals.

<u>Class 3</u> Novice 80-85cm Team & Individual Qualifier All team riders automatically count as individuals.

<u>Class 4</u> Intermediate 90-95cm Team & Individual Qualifier. All team riders automatically count as individuals.

<u>Class 5</u> 1m-1.05 Open Team & Individual Qualifier All team riders automatically count as individuals.

<u>Class 6a/b</u> 1.10m Advanced Open Individual Qualifier 2 x horses and 2 x ponies to qualify. This class will be split into 5a) Horses, 5b) Ponies

All classes are run single phase. Team and Individual rosettes 1st-6th place

Entry Fee £19 per class (£20 for any additional classes entered on the day) includes first aid fee

Cancellation / amendments – cancellations can be made up to close of entries and either moved to another show or refunded (less MRL booking fee) changes can be made without charge up to and on the event date. Showground – please pick up any dropping and hay from around your lorry / tailer before leaving. Do not leave horses tied to lorries unattended. Please keep all dogs on leads, dogs are not allowed in the café.
