Class 1 40cm Team & Individual Grass Roots Qualifier (may be led/assisted) Judged on style. Not timed, Entry Fee £18.00

Class 2 50cm Team & Individual Grass Roots Qualifier (may be assisted) Optimum time, Entry Fee £18.00

Class 3 60cm Team & Individual Grass Roots Qualifier (may not be assisted) Single phase, Entry Fee £18.00 a) Restricted b) Open**

Class 4 5 70cm Team & Individual Grass Roots Qualifier (may not be assisted) Single phase, Entry Fee £18.00 a) Restricted b) Open**

Classes 5-7 NSEA 30cm Rule applies

Class 5 70-75 cm RPL Teams & Individuals Open to all Single phase, Entry Fee £20.00

Class 6 80-85cm RPL Teams & Individuals Single phase, Entry Fee £20.00

Class 7 90-95cm RPL Teams & Individuals Single phase, Entry Fee £20.00
