The highest placed team will qualify for NSEA SJ Championship 2025. A school may qualify a maximum of 1 team for the finals at the NSEA Championships

Hickstead Elite 1m Team Qualifier

The top team will qualify to compete at Hickstead 2025 Teams of 3 or 4, best 3 scores to count. 1 round, single phase.



Hickstead Elite 1.10 Individual Qualifier

The top 2 horses & ponies will qualify to compete at Hickstead 2025 Individual 1.10m qualifiers for section a) horses and section b) ponies (separate sections) Distances will be shortened in combinations for the pony section.1 round single phase.

This competition is open to schools from all counties and will count for RPL points. All classes are single phase. Entries to: NSEA Online entry system
